Your Cireco bin guidance

Bin presentation



Your Cireco bin will be emptied between **7am** and **6pm** on your collection day.



Please ensure your bin lid is closed, there is no waste beside the bin and it is not too heavy.



General Waste bins should contain light, compactable waste only.



Recycling bins should contain loose materials only, not in bags.



Please make sure bottles and cans are empty and have no food residue or liquids.



There is no waste beside the bin unless you have a contract for bundled cardboard. Side waste will not be collected.

Contaminated and overfull bins

If your bin contains the wrong materials, compacted material, or is overfull, then we may not be able to empty your bin. We will put a sticker on your bin explaining why your bin was not emptied. Your bin will then be emptied on its next scheduled collection day, as long as the wrong material is removed.

Recycling bins containing the wrong materials can be emptied by our general mixed waste collection, a charge is applied for this service.

If you need to arrange a general waste collection or require additional bins please contact us.

Dry mixed recycling

BLUE BIN OR CLEAR BAGS



What goes in your **dry mixed recycling** bin or bag?

All of your cans, plastic bottles, paper and cardboard can be recycled in your blue bin. Even plastic films and wrappers!

PLASTIC	Bottles (including tops) from food and drink products, shampoo/conditioner/ shower gel/soap bottles, cleaning products, beauty products, tablet and medicines. Small bottles from yoghurt drinks etc. Food and drink pots, tubs and trays of all colours, plastic vending cups. All plastic wrapping, bags, film and packaging including carrier and bread bags, sauce sachets, crisps and sweet wrappers, biscuit and chocolate wrappers, cling film and bubble wrap.
METALS	Tins and cans from food and drink packaging, aerosols for personal use e.g deoderant, hairspray etc). Foil containers such as takeaways or apple pie.
PAPER	Newspaper, magazines, pamphlets, directories, envelopes (including windows), brochures, office paper, letters, catalogues and unwanted mail.
CARDBOARD	Cereal boxes, brown corrugated packaging, sleeves from ready meals, toilet/ kitchen roll tubes, greeting cards, egg boxes, toothpaste boxes etc.
CARTONS	Used for long-life milk, fruit juices, smoothies, dairy alternative milk, chopped tomatoes, passata, liquid baby milk, soup, pulses, custard, pet milk etc.

Do **NOT** put any of the following materials in your dry mixed recycling bin. Please put in other bins as directed.

Glass recycling

GREEN GLASS BIN



What goes in your glass recycling bin?

All of your glass bottles and jars can be recycled in your clear, brown and green lidded glass bins. This includes all of your:

- Wine and beer bottles
- Pasta sauce jars
- Jam jars
- Glass ketchup bottles

Do **NOT** put any of the following materials in your glass recycling bin. Please put in other bins as directed.

General mixed waste bags	General mixed waste (Non-recycling)
Pyrex Dishes	General mixed waste (Non-recycling)
Windows	General mixed waste (Non-recycling)
Bottles/jars with food/ liquid still in	General mixed waste (Non-recycling)
Plastic packaging	Dry mixed recycling
Plastic and metal – bottle and jar lids	Dry mixed recycling
Food Waste	Food Waste recycling

Please make sure bottles and jars are empty and contain no food residue or liquids.

GENERAL MIXED WASTE BIN OR BAGS



What goes in your **general mixed waste** bin or bag?

Your general mixed waste bin is for all non-recyclable material.

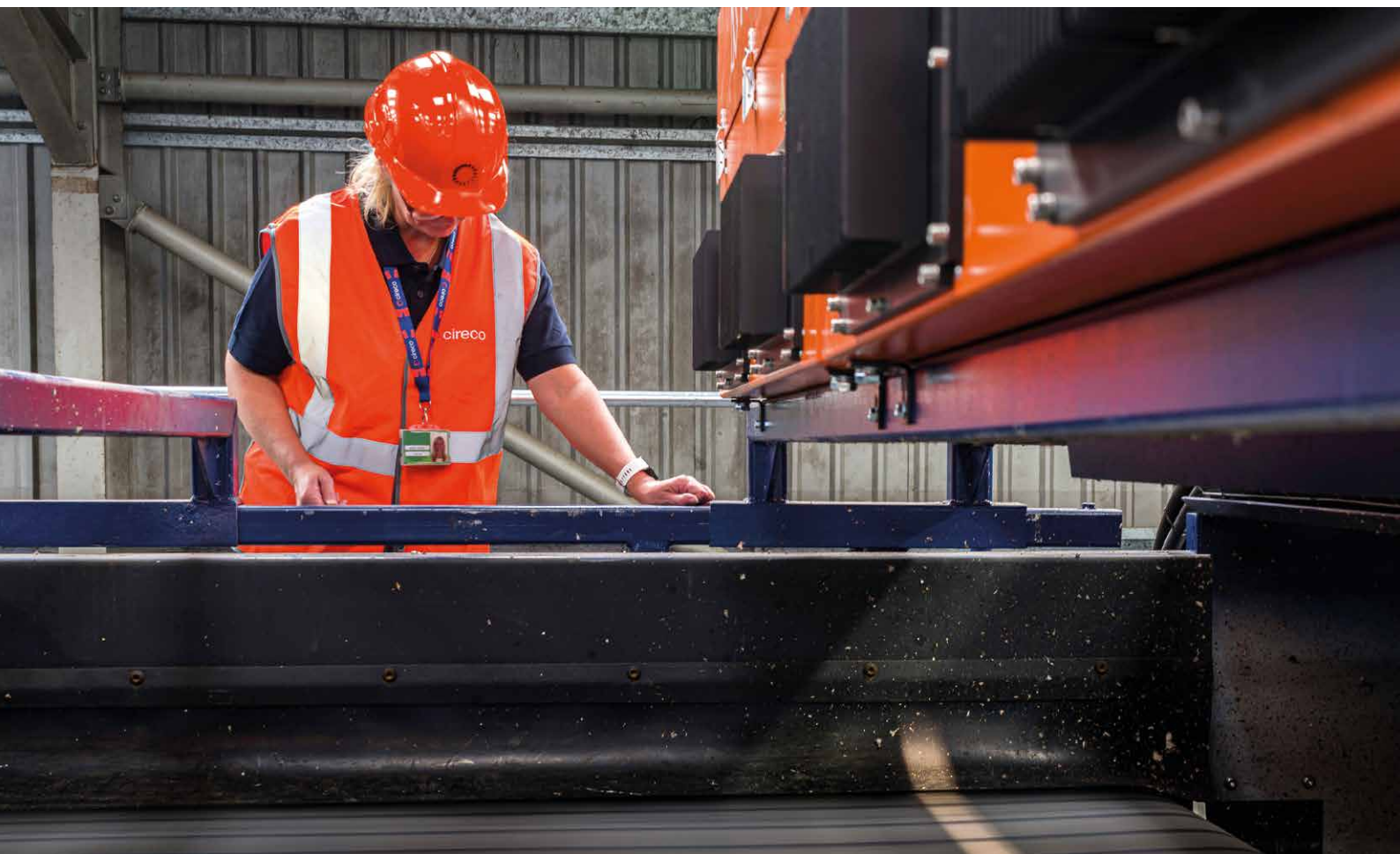
This includes:

MIXED WASTE

KITCHEN ROLL, BLUE ROLL, TISSUES AND PAPER NAPKINS

ANY ITEM STILL CONTAINING FOOD OR DRINK

You have a legal duty under the Waste (Scotland) Regulations 2012 to take all reasonable steps to recycle as much of your waste as possible.



Food waste recycling

BROWN BIN



What goes in your food waste recycling bin?

All of your food waste can be recycled in your brown food waste recycling bin.
All cooked and uncooked food waste including:

BREAD, CAKES AND PASTRIES
CHEESE
EGG (INCLUDING EGG SHELLS)
FRUIT AND VEGETABLES (INCLUDING PEELINGS)
MEAT AND FISH (INCLUDING BONES AND CARCASSES)
PASTA, RICE AND NOODLES
PLATE SCRAPINGS
TEA BAGS AND COFFEE GROUNDS

Do **NOT** put any of the following materials in your food waste recycling bin.
Please use other bins as directed.

General mixed waste bags	General mixed waste (Non-recycling)
Animal Waste	General mixed waste (Non-recycling)
Liquids such as cooking oil or soup/stock	General mixed waste (Non-recycling)
Plastics containing food	General mixed waste (Non-recycling)
Bottles/cans/jars with food waste still in	General mixed waste (Non-recycling)

We can provide food waste bags and caddies to collect your food waste. Food waste bags can be put into your food waste bin for composting.

Food bin presentation

- Collection is between **midnight** and **23:59** on your bin collection day.
- Please ensure your bin lid is closed, there is no waste beside the bin, it is not too heavy and that there is no liquid in the bin.
- Do not put food waste in plastic bags, only compostable bags with the compostable logo.
